4) Hazard to health specific to dusty products.

There are some signs which may indicate over exposure such as irritations to eyes or skin. If swallowed there may be signs of sickness with actual vomiting. Medical attention should be sought if conditions persist.

Dust masks must be worn when applying or storing the product.

Some existing medical conditions may be further aggravated by exposure such as Dermatitis and Asthma. It is not known if there are any carcinogenicity implications.

5) First aid. In all cases of unusual contact seek medical help.

Ingestion:- thoroughly rinse mouth with copious amounts of water. Drink water.

Skin:- Wash thoroughly especially before eating.

Eyes:- Flush with eyewash .

Inhalation:- Seek fresh air

6) Fire and explosion Data.

There are no particular hazards involved as the material is hard to ignite however the usual precautions should be taken as with any dusty product. If on fire avoid the spread by wetting the surface of adjacent material.

Stability:- The product is generally stable but refer to storage section of data sheet.

Incompatibility:- Micro organisms may be affected by Acids and Alkalis.

Hazardous Polymerization:- Not hazardous. Refer to storage section of data sheet

8) Physical and Chemical characteristics.

Appearance:- Greyish colour with short fibres and china clay dust particles.

Bulk density:- Approximately 500kg per cubic meter.

Odour:- There is little odour to fresh product but it does change as the product gets older.

Volatile % by volume:- N/A. Specific gravity:- N/A. Boiling point:- N/A. Solubility in water:- Very slightly.

Vapour pressure:- N/A. Vapour density:- N/A.

9) Regulatory Information.

The product is not hazardous as regulated by DOT (Department of Transport) DOT labelling is not applicable.

TSCA:- (transport substances control act) N/A.

10) Precautions and protection.

Ensure good ventilation and avoid breathing dust. A dust mask is essential in heavy exposure. Eye protection is also recommended in heavy exposure. Gloves are not required unless sensitivity or any allergic reaction occurs.

Storage of Cozi-Bed/Cozi-Blends

Cozi-bed is made from waste sourced from the paper recycling industry therefor there may be variations in the finished product.

The product should be tipped in a covered storage building. It should be clean, dry, well ventilated area, free from any ingress of moisture.

Avoid piling the product up above about 2 meters high and avoid driving on it causing compression. It is important not to allow damp farmyard dirt to enter the product (i.e. from loading shovel or tractor wheels, or from a contaminated bucket) any moisture of this kind which then gets entrained into the pile can cause a build-up of unwanted yeasts and moulds.

Always try to operate a first in first out basis avoid tipping a new load in front of an unused portion of a previous load.

Mixing this product with any other product is done so entirely at your own risk.

If you tip Cozi-bed into a walled store for the first time you may notice some material sticking to the wall as you remove the bedding. This is due to the very absorbent nature of the bedding which will suck any moisture out of the wall. This bedding is best scraped off the wall and used as soon as possible.

Please note that this information is given with the intention of guiding the user about the management of Cozi-bed however the information is true of most bedding types especially where the bedding is very dry. Good management can help to avoid problems.
